### Agenda

Call to Order by Division Commander Bridwell

The roll call found 16 present and 4 absent; with a quorum established.

Compatriot Al Perry presented a motion for the Division to fund a \$495 scholarship for a youngster to attend the Sam Davis Youth Camp. An amendment was made to the motion to fund two scholarships, one each for a youngster from the Northern and Southern sections of the State. Motion passed.

Division Adjutant Tim Pilgrim stated that the City of Kennesaw made a request if the Georgia Division can help in the restoration of the Georgia 65<sup>th</sup> Volunteer Infantry Battle Flag that was donated to the Southern Museum of Locomotive History in Kennesaw. The City of Kennesaw funded the replacement of the flagpoles at the Confederate Monument without accepting the funds offered by the SCV and was hoping that some of those funds could be applied toward the restoration of the 65<sup>th</sup> Georgia Flag. A motion was made that the Georgia Division fund ½ of the requested \$3,000 and the local Camps will raise the other. Motion was seconded and passed.

The Stone Mountain Memorial Camp #1432 requested that the Georgia Division assist the Camp with erecting a flagpole in the Stone Mountain Memorial Cemetery. They have gotten approval from the City

of Stone Mountain in writing and wanted to proceed with the erection of the pole as soon as possible. A motion was made by Judge Advocate Dan Coleman that competitive pricing be obtained and project be submitted to the project committee for review upon review a vendor will be selected and will be funded from the tag funds. A \$4,000 cap will be placed on the project, the motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Division Lt Commander North, Joel Coleman, indicated that the Division was running out of the 4ft X 8ft recruitment signs and made a motion that 100 more signs be purchased to re-stock our supply. Motion was seconded and passed.

Judge Advocate Dan Coleman, suggested that the Division should give the Georgia Confederate of the Year trophy to the recipient, rather than it being passed on to each recipient. Division Adjutant Tim Pilgrim stated that he would get pricing for a new trophy and present it at the next EC meeting.

The meeting adjourned.
